



Children in Care Council

The Children in Care Council (CiCC) is a great way for young people to get involved in shaping the services they receive. The Young People Looked After (YPLA) team helps children and young people who want to take part by supporting them with the meetings and getting involved with different projects including:

- inspecting residential homes
- helping to organise and deliver events for fostered young people (including the annual achievement awards event)
- training foster carers
- interviewing social workers and managers.

There are also other opportunities to get involved with different projects throughout the year.

The CiCC has a number of groups:

Juniors	for ages 8 to 12
Seniors	for ages 13 to 18
Care leavers	for ages 16 to 21, or 25 if they have a disability or are in full time education or training.

The groups are a great way to meet other looked after young people and have a say in the services for looked after young people.
