

Nottinghamshire CSE/CSA Support Service

The Children's Society CSE/CSA Support Service is based in Nottinghamshire and commissioned by Nottinghamshire City Council and Nottinghamshire Clinical Commissioning Group.



As of July 1 2016, The Children's Society took over the delivery of the Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) and Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) support service in Nottinghamshire.

The Children's Society is a national charity that has been providing services for children and young people for over 130 years. Locally they have been delivering services in Nottingham City for over 20 years.

The CSE service aims to:

- Contribute to enabling children to move towards a safer and more settled lifestyle and recover from sexual exploitation;
- Reduce the number of children experiencing CSE in Nottinghamshire through preventative strategies;
- Increase the numbers of children identified at an earlier stage;
- Increase the number of children at risk of, or victim to CSE, accessing quality specialist support.

The CSA service aims to:

- Provide therapeutic support to victims/survivors of CSE/CSA in order to minimise the impact of the abuse on their mental health and emotional well-being;
- Promote resilience and enhance prospects of positive outcomes;
- Aid children and young people to access other specialist support.
