

Letterbox Club 2018

Nottinghamshire's Virtual School and Inspire Libraries will be again working together to run The Letterbox Club. This will be the ninth year the scheme has been available in Nottinghamshire.

If you haven't yet come across it, the programme aims to inspire a love of reading and engagement with numeracy for 'Looked After' children. It is targeted at particular school year groups. Children who are in years 1, 3, 5 or 7 receive a parcel direct to their address, once a month between May and October. There is also a parcel for 'early years' children who are aged 3 or 4 (and haven't already received parcels in 2017).

Parcels contents:

- A range of **carefully selected books** from different genres.
- Fun **number games** that can be played individually or as a group.
- **Stationery items**, for writing and drawing, and other supportive materials.
- Some of the parcels also include **letters from children's authors**.

If you currently care for a child in the year groups mentioned above, you should soon receive a letter to welcome them to the scheme.

The Letterbox Club is a national initiative and overseen by Booktrust (an independent reading charity), in partnership with the University of Leicester. The contents of the parcels are chosen by Booktrust, but we can make adjustments to make sure the parcels are best suited to the child you care for, therefore, please contact us at any time throughout the scheme if you have questions or requests for changes.
