Broxtowe Youth Homelessness have teamed up with Nottinghamshire County Council and Futures to ensure care leavers in Nottinghamshire have the skills and opportunities they need to become successful, independent adults.

Care leavers are disproportionately more likely to experience unemployment, mental health issues and homelessness. To try and combat these outcomes Nottinghamshire County Council launched the Care Leavers Offer, which provides additional support to help care leavers transition into independent living.

Nottinghamshire County Council are now looking at the next stage of the offer, which includes upskilling young people whilst still in care.

Broxtowe Youth Homelessness have been commissioned to develop and deliver a work readiness programme to prepare young people in care for a meaningful work placement.

We recognise the transferrable skills young people in care gain throughout their lives and we are passionate about applying them in the workplace.





The Care 2 Work programme consists of three steps —

- 1. A fun, interactive 2-day workshop designed to help young people identify a potential career path and prepare for a work placement.
- 2. Participate in a well planned and meaningful work placement in an area of work of their choice.
- 3. Continued support from Futures to help young people to progress on their desired career path.
